## Strike authorization votes to be held Sunday, August 28

A vital part of the Detroit Three bargaining process takes place this weekend when members of Unifor's Master Agreement auto locals vote to give their bargaining committees a strike mandate.

"The best thing members can do right now to help their bargaining committees is to give them a strong strike authorization vote," said Unifor National President Jerry Dias.

All members are encouraged to attend the meeting for their local, and vote. **Times and places are listed in this newsletter, and available from your local.**

Only those present will have a vote. The strike authorization will be based on votes cast at the meeting. There is no such thing as an automatic **Yes or No vote** for those who do not attend the meeting.

Each meeting will include an update from your bargaining committees on the talks.

**No strike can be called until after September 19**, and only then if talks break down or members from the target company reject a contract offer put to them for ratification.

The target, which will set the pattern contract for each of the Detroit Three, will be picked September 6, the day after Labour Day.

Be sure to attend the vote for your local. A high turnout will strengthen your bargaining committees as they head back into negotiations with the Detroit Three the very next morning.

The decision to go on strike is never taken lightly, and will only be made if absolutely necessary.

A strong strike authorization sends a clear message to the Detroit Three that the members are behind their bargaining committees.

## Strike preparations begin

Representatives from each Master Agreement local of the Detroit Three automakers met last week to discuss preparations in the event of a strike during the current round of contract talks.

Barb Dolan, Director of Unifor's Strike and Defence Fund, outlined for the group the steps affected locals must go through if a strike is called, and reviewed the legal right to strike in Canada.

**"The right to strike is part of our fundamental rights of expression and assembly in Canada."**

Organizing a strike takes a great deal of planning, so cannot be left to the last minute.

In the weeks ahead, you will likely see your local making preparations to be ready to strike, if it comes to that, even if your Detroit Three company is not the pattern target picked on September 6. This is only prudent and just good planning.

For the pattern target company, strike preparation will pick up significantly in the weeks ahead. Picket headquarters will be established, signs will be put together and more.

Your local will provide more information, including how you can help, in the coming weeks.
