The Council will convene on Friday, August 18 at 9:00 a.m. and will adjourn by noon on Sunday, August 20. The Council will take place in the Ballroom on the second level of the Convention Centre.

In addition, we invite you to attend the Bargaining Worker Power - Unifor's Collective Bargaining Program Summit happening on Thursday, August 17, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This day long conference follows dozens of sessions and one of the union's largest engagement of members across the country as we build our worker bargaining program for the future.

There is no registration fee for the Canadian Council, but registration is required in advance and will take place via our online registration system. Your user name and password will be sent directly to the local union president in a separate email.

Industry Council meetings scheduled in conjunction with the Canadian Council will be held on Tuesday, August 15 and Wednesday, August 16. Additional details are enclosed and will be provided by your Council directly.

Local union representation at Canadian Council is governed by Articles 9.8, 9.9 and 9.10 of the Unifor Constitution.

# Registration

# **Delegates to Canadian Council**

Delegates to Canadian Council are as outlined in Articles 9.8, 9.9 and 9.10 of the Unifor Constitution. Your local entitlement will be sent to your local union president directly in a separate email.

#### The deadline to register for Canadian Council is Wednesday, July 19, 2023.

#### Article 9.8

Delegate entitlement and voting strength shall be based on the average national dues payments received by the National Union during the calendar year period prior to Canadian Council excluding any period in which national dues payments have been interrupted by a labour dispute.

Local Unions may apply to the Secretary-Treasurer to send one additional delegate who shall be a woman or from an equity-seeking group with voice and one vote. The Secretary-Treasurer may restrict these delegates according to the cost and space limitations.

To apply for an Additional Equity Delegate, please send an email to <u>registration@unifor.org</u>. All Additional Delegate requests must be received prior to the registration deadline of July 19, 2023.

#### Article 9.9

Delegates to Canadian Council shall be elected by secret ballot with a minimum of 15 days' notice to all members of nominations and elections. Candidates with the most votes will be elected, unless the By-Laws of the Local Union stipulates otherwise.

#### Article 9.10

The following individuals will also be delegates to the Canadian Council with voice and one vote each:

- In addition to the Chairperson, 4 executive members of the Quebec Council and Regional Councils.
- 3 members of each Standing Committee of the Quebec Council and Regional Councils established in the constitution.
- Executive members of Industry Councils.
- Members of the National Executive Board.
- Members of the Executive of the National Retired Workers Council Executive.

# There are no Alternates to Canadian Council. Observers are permitted and must be registered by the deadline.

# **Online Registration**

Registration for the Canadian Council is available online only. Delegate entitlements and each individual local user name and password will be sent directly to the local presidents in a separate email.

If your local chooses to register an additional delegate representing equity you do not need to register them through the online registration system. This will be done automatically once they are approved.

# **Bargaining Worker Power**

# **Unifor's Collective Bargaining Program Summit - August 17**

At its 2022 National Convention in Toronto, Unifor launched an ambitious project to renew its National Collective Bargaining Program as part of its three-year Action Plan. The National Collective Bargaining Program, sets out a series of priorities and principles that will inform its collective bargaining strategy over the next three years.

A key feature of this renewed National Collective Bargaining Program is that the process is informed by the experiences, ideas, and expectations of Unifor local union leadership, bargaining committee representatives and activists. Throughout 2023, the union hosted regional strategy sessions across the country, to gather input directly from members and retirees.

The special one-day National Collective Bargaining Program Summit caps off a year-long project.

Delegates to the Summit will have an opportunity to review, discuss and debate the contents of Unifor's new National Collective Bargaining Program as well as explore ways to better engage members in the bargaining process.

The National Collective Bargaining Program Summit will precede Unifor's 2023 Canadian Council.

All local unions attending Canadian Council are encouraged to send delegates to the summit.

# **COVID-19 Protection**
