Eligibility

Delegates to the Conference

Delegates to this Conference must be skilled workers of journeyperson status in good standing in their local union and Unifor National Skilled Trades Council (UNSTC) and must be elected or selected. Wherein Local Union collective agreements or bylaws provide for Skilled Trades representative(s) to be elected by the Skilled Trades from a skilled occupation, those representative(s) shall attend the Skilled Trades Conference as regular delegate(s).

This procedure has been approved to assure the skilled workers that are elected representative(s) will participate in the collective bargaining process.

Fraternal Delegates to the Conference

Fraternal Delegates shall have voice but no vote and may include non-UNSTC Skilled Trades members, Local Union officers and bargaining committee members.

Fraternal Delegates will be issued credentials based on the following conditions:

- When the Local Union has elected or selected regular Skilled Trades for the conference; or


