Greetings,

Canada's Health Care systems continue to be at the forefront of public concern across the country. There have been some advances on the federal level but there is still much work to do. Provinces continue to underfund the public sector while funding the private sector at higher rates, causing inequities, increased stress and adding to the already existing staffing crisis.

Workers are burnt out and it's time to reconnect, refocus and refresh. We hope you will join us as we share bargaining priorities, best practices and discuss provincial specific health care related issues that are most pressing and concerning to our members.

This year's conference will take place at the Unifor Family Education Centre located at 115 Shipley Avenue in Port Elgin, Ontario. The conference will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 3, 2025, and will adjourn no later than 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 5, 2025. On-site check-in will take place on Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Registration

Conference Registration Fee

There will be a conference registration fee of \$100.00 for conference kit materials. Please mail a separate cheque made payable to the Unifor Family Education Centre.

Unifor Family Education Reservation

To attend this conference you must complete the <u>Unifor Family Education Reservation</u> form and return it to <u>confcentre@unifor.org</u>.

Accommodations on-site will be handled on a first come first served basis. In order to participate in the conference, you must have accommodations made at/by the Centre. If the Centre is fully booked, the Centre staff will advise you (or your local) and will make a reservation off-site at a nearby hotel and notify you with the pertinent reservation information.

Room check-in begins on Friday, October 3 at 3:00 p.m. and closes at 9:00 p.m.

If you are arriving outside of the above noted hours, please ring the buzzer and maintenance will provide you with your accommodation key.

Check-out is at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 5.

Note: If family member(s) are being paid for by the individual and not by the local, the local pays the 'single occupancy' rate and the following rates apply (including taxes):

Please note: Double occupancy units are also equipped with a separate study room which includes a single fold-out 'Murphy bed' for those wishing additional privacy.

If your delegate wishes to share a room, please ensure they note this on their Registration Form. Please endure to indicate if a smoking or accessible room is required.

All outstanding room and board fees, including spouse and children, will be the responsibility of the local union delegates.

Payment Methods

Paying via cheque: please forward two (2) separate cheques to the Unifor Family Education Centre. One for the conference registration fee (\$100.00) and the other for accommodation costs. Cheques can be made payable to the Unifor Family Education Centre and mailed with the enclosed reservation forms directly to the Unifor Family Education Centre, 115 Shipley Ave., Port Elgin, ON NOH 2C5.

Cancellation Policy
