We are pleased to announce that our national Unifor Pride Conference will take place at the Unifor Family Education Centre in Port Elgin from April 28th – 30th, 2023. The Pride Conference is a bilingual event for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, two-spirit, intersex (LGBTQ2SI) members to gain skills and build knowledge. Allies' activism and support is important for campaigns and progress year-round, but this conference is a space for members of the LGBTQ2SI community to work together.

Conference delegates will have the opportunity to hear about some of the tremendous work being done within our union and our communities. Through participation in skills-building workshops and conversations hosted by LGBTQ2SI activists and leaders, delegates will gain knowledge and build relationships they can bring back to their local union and to advocate for equity.

This conference will address current challenges, threats, and opportunities for queer and trans workers and give space for LGBTQ2SI Unifor members to build a supportive, inclusive union movement and more equitable local unions.

Childcare

Free child care is available for children 0-12 years of age, of eligible delegates during the conference hours only, if numbers permit. Delegates will be eligible for child care providing they are a single parent, or a parent not accompanied by a spouse or companion. Where both parents are registered delegates, they will also qualify for child care. Child care registration forms are enclosed. Please make your child care reservations as early as possible.

Delegates requiring child care must pre-register no later than Friday, March 31st, 2023.

If the Centre is fully booked, the Centre will advise you and you (or your local) will be responsible for making alternative arrangements. For those delegates and family required to stay off-site, please note that it is still mandatory to purchase the meal plan and to check in with the front desk at the Unifor Family Education Centre.

Meals

All meals are included in the overnight rate for all guests and will be served cafeteria style, starting with supper on the day of check-in and end with lunch on the day of check-out. If any participants require special meal requirements or have any dietary concerns (food allergies), please advise us in advance of your arrival.
