Maximum Score in each category is 5 – a plus (+) or a minus (-) sign may be noted in cases where committee agrees it may help with scoring. Membership Meeting – score is based on frequency of attendance to monthly meetings and special meetings such as ratification (sign in sheets may be used to verify if necessary).

Community, Protests, Demos – one point for each protest or demo attended and one point for each volunteer community work such as coaching, Big Sisters etc. (if actions noted are very old score can be lowered – highest score should go to most recent activities).

Standing Committees – one point for each standing committee and an extra point for committee chairs. Additional points can be assigned for long and/or exceptional service on a committee.

Education – one point for each union school attended on their own time. Week long PEL or H&S courses are not given a score to the same level as a weekend course as they are on paid time. If there are multiple PEL or H&S courses listed they can each count as half a point.

Comments – here we are looking for a commitment to learning about the union, a willingness to share with other members what they learn and a commitment to activism once they return. The comments should not demonstrate a self-serving motive – such as "want something for my next election flyer" Equity – this section is used if there is a tie between several applicants or if the PEL delegates are not at all diverse and there is a member from an equity seeking group who is very close in score. This is utilized at the discretion of the committee with the goal of promoting equality and diversity.
